TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A minimum of four members are required to make up a team with a maximum of eight. If you are short of four, ask us and we will try to join you in a team.
2. Team Leaders must be at least 17 years of age. It is the responsibility of team leaders to ensure all team members between the ages of 12 and 16 have signed consent of a parent or guardian or be accompanied by a recognised Youth Leader. Entrants under the age of 12 in a family or young person's group may be accepted if accompanied by a parent, guardian or recognised youth leader – please advise us in advance.
3. All walkers must be suitably clothed and equipped in accordance with the Kit Checklist provided. A high visibility jacket, with a prominent team number, will be provided for the team leader – all other team members must wear their own high visibility clothing. It is a condition of entry that the team leader returns this jacket at the final check point or before the wearer leaves the course.
4. All walkers take part in the event at their own risk.
5. The section of the Kit Checklist 'Take care of the countryside and of yourselves' must be fully complied with and in particular DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
6. The Moonraker Challenge is organised by the Moonraker Committee which consists of members of the Rotary Club of Taunton Vale. The event is run for the purpose of raising funds for our stated beneficiaries. Each entrant should be sponsored and is expected to raise a minimum of £25 each or £15 in the case of entrants 16 years of age or under for the benefit of the nominated charities. Team leaders are responsible for ensuring this money is paid by the deadline of 30th November 2019.
7. The registration fee of £20 or £5 for those aged 16 or under, must be paid in full before a team can enter and book a time slot. This entry fee is to cover the cost of the event which includes hot food and drink at the half way stage. An ambulance and first aid team stationed throughout the event; Radio cover provided by Raynet over the entire area with a Search and Rescue team on the course throughout the event until every walker is cleared from the course. In addition, the prizegiving evening and meal in November is free of charge.
8. Entries can be made on line or by post using the Registration Form which can be downloaded. Entries by post should be accompanied by a cheque for the entry fees made payable to the Rotary Club of Taunton Vale Trust Fund and sent to Jas Shorney at the address below. Payment for entries made on-line should be made direct to the Bank Account – **Rotary Club of Taunton Vale Trust Fund HSBC Taunton Sort code 40-44-04 Account Number 71202812**. Entries will not be confirmed until payment is received.
9. Starting times will be allocated on a first come first served basis, early booking will avoid disappointment.
10. Entries will close on 30th September 2019.
